The prizewinning swimmer's watch, the Ahoi, features a stainless steel case, rhodium-plated hour and minute hands, and white silver-plated galvanised dial. Nomos is committed to producing its own calibres in-house. "Last year, our Neomatik timepieces went into series, and with the model Tetra joining it, we have equipped another Nomos classic with our latest automatic calibre DUW 3001," says CEO Uwe Ahrendt. "In spring 2017, Nomos Glashütte presented new Neomatik models as part of the Aqua series: beautifully robust and extra water-resistant watches available in eye-catching colours." Later, "we launched a new watch series of classic men's timepieces to look good in the office, Nomos At Work. These are watches with the perfect proportions for male wrists and incredibly slender cases in a striking shade of cool grey." And there's more still, but you'll have to wait.
